

Is it already too late?

Today, more than ever, confronted with the murderous lunacy of the world elite, there are voices that deserve respect and attention.

The first is that of the late Cardinal Bernard Law, Archbishop of Boston in the United States, well and truly abandoned by his ecclesiastical colleagues - “responsibles” - the day he confronted President Bush about “HIS” truth in a personal letter.

The second is none other than the Jewish French novelist, Jacob Cohen, who has been persecuted since the 27th November 2012 when he dared to confront the Israeli officials with “THEIR” truth in a powerful article.

Therefore, I will attempt to revive some buried memories by reproducing this letter and this article in full and I will conclude with one question, yes one question.

1. Letter from Cardinal Law

«Mr. President

Tell the people the truth about terrorism Mr. President. If the illusions about terrorism are not destroyed then the threat will continue until our complete destruction. The truth is that none of our many nuclear weapons can protect us from these threats. No Star Wars system (no matter how advanced or how many billions of dollars are squandered on these projects) will protect us from a nuclear weapon carried in a boat plane or rented car.

No weapon in our vast arsenal nor a cent of the \$270 million wasted each year on the so-called “defense system,” can prevent a terrorist bomb. It is a military fact. As a retired lieutenant colonel and attendee at frequent conferences on the subject of national security, I have always quoted Psalm 33: "A king is not saved by his mighty army, nor is a warrior saved saved by his vigor." Mr. President, you were not truthful about “why” we are the target of terrorism when you explained why we were bombing Afghanistan and Sudan. You said we were the target of terrorism because we defend democracy, freedom and human rights in the world.

This is absurd Mr. President.

We are the target of terrorism because globally our government has defended dictatorship, slavery and human exploitation. We are the target of terrorists because we are hated and we are hated because we have done terrible things.

In how many countries have US government agents ousted leaders elected by their people, replacing them with military dictators, puppets, eager to sell out their own people to multi-national American interests?

We did this in Iran. US Marines and the CIA deposed Mossadegh because he wanted to nationalise the oil industry. We replaced him with Shah Reza Pahlevi and we armed and trained his detested National Guard, Savak, which enslaved and brutalised the people of Iran to protect the financial interests of US oil companies. Since then, is it so difficult to comprehend that we are hated by the people of Iran?

We did the same in Chile, in Vietnam. More recently we tried to do the same in Iraq. It is clear! How many times have we done this in Nicaragua and other Latin American Republics?

One after another we have removed popular leaders who wanted to distribute the nation's wealth for the benefit of the people. We replaced them with murderous tyrants who betrayed their own people - in return for huge sums being paid into their private bank accounts - so that the wealth of the country could be appropriated by corporations like Domino Sugar, United Fruit Company, Folgers and others.

In country after country our regime obstructed democracy, stifled freedom and trampled human rights. This is why we are hated in the world and this is why we are targeted by terrorists.

The people of Canada enjoy freedom and human rights as do the people of Norway and Sweden. Have you heard of Canadian, Norwegian or Swedish embassies being bombed? We are not hated because we practice democracy, freedom or human rights. We are hated because our regime denies these practices to the people of third world countries whose resources are coveted by US multinational groups.

This hatred that we have sown turns against us with the threat of terrorism and in the future - nuclear terrorism.

Once the truth has been told about the reasons behind this threat and once it has been heard the solution becomes obvious. We must change our practices.

Freeing ourselves from nuclear weapon development (even unilaterally if necessary) will improve our security. Drastically changing our foreign policy will consolidate it. [..]

In short, we should be good, instead of bad. Who, then, would try to stop us? Who would hate us? Who would want to bomb us?

This is the truth, Mr. President.

This is what the American people need to hear.

2. Jacob Cohen article
