PSYCHIATRIC REPORT

At the request of Father Elias Zahlaoui, I interviewed Myrna Nazzour on June 30th, 1997.

The purpose of the interview was to evaluate the psychiatric status of Myrna.

Generally, Myrna appeared calm, related well to the interviewer. She was not in any apparent distress and showed no abnormality in her psychomotor activity.

Her mood was cheerful and congruent to her thoughts. Her mental stream showed no evidence of loosening of association and the content showed as hallucilation, delusion or any psychotic material.

Her judgement and insight were good.

In brief, I have found no evidence at osychools nor psychotic thought process. I can say without any Eddin' Sound hesitation that Myrna does not show my psychopathology. She is mentally sound.

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
